Challenging competitors' focus and concentration, auditory and visual reactions, and calculating capabilities in abacus dictation and flash mental math. Competitors will test themselves through three stages of increasingly difficult problems in two different competitions.

Competition Content:

- (1) Abacus Dictation, Addition and Subtraction;
- (2) Flash Mental Math, Addition and Subtraction.



During the abacus portion, an abacus is permitted but not required; during the mental math portion, an abacus is not permitted; in both parts, no calculator is allowed.

Competition Groups: Six Elementary School Groups (one each for Grades 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6), one Junior High School Group (consisting of Grades 7 and 8), and one High School Group (consisting of Grades 9 through 12), for a total of eight groups.

Qualifications: Students who have learnt abacus and mental math and are currently in Grades 1-12 are eligible to enter.

Ways to Register: (1) Students of CAAA teachers should submit the form to their teacher; (2) Students of non-CAAA teachers **must** apply through the website at <http://caaa-abacus.weebly.com>.
