This training seminar is a two-day program that is intended to help participants acquire and strengthen skill sets that serve as tools for running a successful abacus class. Emphasis will be placed on understanding basic teaching principles, which include but are not limited to developing course syllabi, lesson plans, lectures, and supplemental learning material; practicum, which offers opportunities for group and individual practice with teaching, and discussion, during which distinguished guest speakers and abacus instructors will impart their knowledge and experiences in education.
